Continuing Competency Compliance

On April 29, 2022, the Board of Registration of Allied Health Professions promulgated regulations requiring continuing competency activities as a prerequisite to licensure renewal. The Board will begin enforcing these requirements beginning with renewals due in September 2022. During the first 24 months, licensees must have completed the following units of continuing competence programs or other activities as part of their renewal obligations and attestations:

Please be advised that the Board will accept for satisfaction of their continuing competency obligation in the period renewals are due from September 2022 through July 2024 any appropriate and documented continuing competency activity that occurred in the renewal period—i.e., including continuing competency activities that predate the effective date and the enforcement date of the Board's continuing competency regulations.

Then, beginning with all renewals due in August 2024 forward, all licensees must have completed the required 24 continuing competency units to renew their licenses. Please note, during the period renewals are due from September 2022 through July 2024, the mandatory 2-unit requirement in law and ethics will not be enforced, but this requirement will be enforced beginning with all renewals due in August 2024.
